Notice

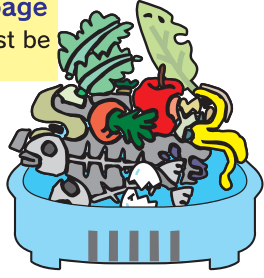
- Waste without separation will not be collected.
- Compound materials must be disassembled as much as you can
- Waste put in a black bag or a carton will not be collected because we don't know what is inside.
- Waste accumulation is managed by each area.
- Let's cooperate and follow the rules and regulations of waste collection sites.

Three times a week

Garbage

Kitchen garbage
Garbage must be dehydrated.



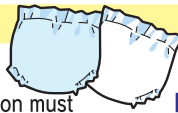
Sanitary paper

Excretion must be cast off.



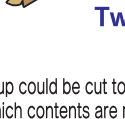
Paper containers



Garden grasses

Woods

Remove metallic objects such as nails



Chairs



Desks



Scrapped woods

Tree branches and twigs unable to be tied up could be cut to under 30cm in length and put into rice bags on which contents are marked.

- Wooden furniture must be destroyed to under 30cm in length. Metallic objects such as nails must be removed. (You could contact an official licensed dealer if you have no idea. There may be a charge.)
- Tree branches and twigs have to be cut to under 30cm in length and 10cm in diameter.
- Clothes that can't be recycled have to be cut to under 30cm in length.
- Garbage can be recycled as store compost by the use of a household garbage disposer. Your full cooperation will be greatly appreciated.
- Collect fine wastes in **clear or translucent bags**.

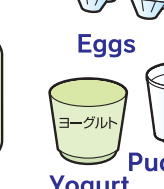

Lids must be taken off.

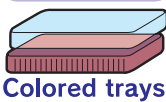

Cushion materials

Those (foamed styrol) that are used to protect electric appliances.

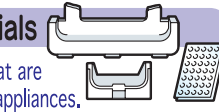
Those that can not be cleaned should be put in combustible waste.

Medical wastes (e.g intravenous drip, syringes, etc.) will not be collected.

Plastic bags

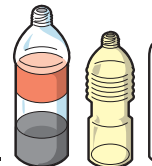
①use contents completely ②take lids off ③rinse well ④dry well ⑤put into clear bags

- Some containers will need to be slit to clean properly.
- Food and drink dreg can't be removed or something too small to clean such as natto mustard bag should be put in combustible waste.
- Something made of composite materials (e.g pump style lids) that can't be separated should be classified as "noncombustible waste"(buried waste).
- Cushion materials must be destroyed to under 10cm in length.

Plastic bottles (Pet Bottle)
Twice a month

Note Bottles which **1** PET mark.

Lids and plastic labels belong to "Plastic products and containers".



[Cleaning instructions]

Remove lids and any foreign objects.



Rinse well and dry completely.



Crush.



Collect in **clear bags**.

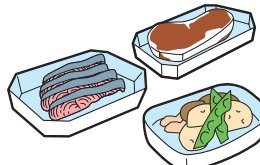


- Remove lids and labels.
- Rinse well and crush.
- Collect in **clear bags**.
- No need to remove the rings from the bottles.

White trays
Once a month

Note White tray both side with **プラ** or **6** mark.

Trays with color must be put in plastic containers.



[Cleaning instructions]

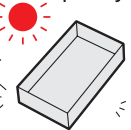
Remove contents, wrappings, and stickers.



Rinse well.



Dry completely.



- Remove food dreg or wrappings from trays, rinse well, dry completely and collect in **clear bags**.
- Please drop them into the recycling promotion boxes near some super markets.

Bottles
Once a month



Brown bottles Clear bottles Others

If the colors of body and neck are different, please separate according to the color of neck.

Try to return beer and 1800ml sake bottles to the place of purchase.

Sheet glass must be cleaned and will be collected on designated Sunday collection days (10 times a year) and places. Please refer to waste calendar.

- Only bottles of food, beverage and cosmetics are allowed.
- Please take the lid off and rinse bottles well. Bottles are divided into brown, colorless transparent and other three types.
- Lids are divided into "Plastic products and containers" and "Cans and hardwares" waste.

Cans and Hardwares
small electric appliances · umbrella
Once a month

Separate out by types

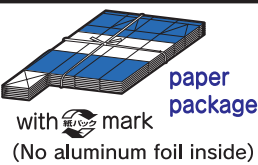
- boiler · cutter · others**: Kettles, Pots, Umbrellas
- electric appliances**: Toaster ovens, Kerosene heaters, Fan heaters, Hair dryers, Vacuum cleaners, VCRs
- Steel can**: Juice, with **3** mark
- Aluminum can**: Beer, with **27E** mark
- Exception Bicycles**: Collectable regardless of size

①Battery or Oil must be removed.
②Household appliances recycle laws list objects are not allowed.

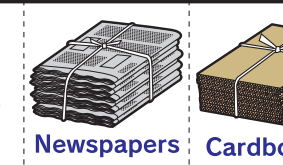
Collect fine wastes into **clear or translucent bags**.

- Things 1m in length only.
- Spray cans, aerosols, and gas cylinders have to be punctured.
- Knives and other sharp objects must be wrapped to ensure safe handling. Small sharp objects must be put into a steel can. The can opening must also be crushed shut.
- Bicycle and tricycle are marked with 「不用」
- electric appliances (body less than 1m in length) are limited to those powered on batteries or outlet
- Materials composing of metal and plastics or metal and wood are taken out as "Cans and Hardwares" waste.

Papers and Cloths
Once a month



paper package with **紙** mark (No aluminum foil inside)



Newspapers Cardboards

Magazines Magazines, comics, snack boxes, fillers and toilet paper core. Including containers and packings with **紙** mark.



Cloths Cotton only **towel and blanket**

- Recyclable paper products must be tied according to type.
- Cloth that are made from chemical fiber or very dirty must be cut to under 30cm in length and taken out as "Combustible waste".
- Remove the tapes and metallic objects from cartons.

Buried waste
Once a month

Separate out by types

- Plastic products**: Plastic buckets, Plastic tanks (Kerosene must be removed)
- Rubber and leather products**: Shoes, Rubber Boots
- Others**: Bags, Tooth brushes
- Glasses and Ceramics**: Mirrors, Glasses, Dishes (Ceramics and Glasses), Vases, Heat-resistant glasses, Flowerpots
- Disposable lighter**: must be used completely and destroyed.

- Things 1m in length only. (including ski length will not collect more than 1m.)
- Collect fine wastes into **clear or translucent bags**.
- Dangerous stuff such as broken glass or ceramics must be wrapped with paper and put into rice bags on which contents are marked.
- Hose and vinyl sheet must be tied up to under 1m in length.
- Charcoal ash must be put into a bag and marked "灰".

Designated collection sites
Please refer to "waste & recycle guide", city bulletin or homepage.

Batteries Light bulbs and tubes
Please drop them into the recycle boxes of electric appliances shops or super markets
Batteries accepted are dry, button, mercury, lithium, NiCad, and those from mobile phones.
Light bulbs and tubes (in round, tube or ball shape).
Thermometers contain mercury.

Lighter
Long-shank disposable lighter
Disposable lighter
Please bring it to collecting shops if you can't break it. Please refer to bulletin (March 10th) for the shops list.

used edible oil
please drop it into the recycle boxes of super markets
used edible oil are limited to liquid vegetable oil
please put it in plastic containers such as PET bottles
please make sure that caps are firmly closed and no oil leaks

Uncollectible Waste (Please dispose of properly.)

- household appliances recycle laws list objects (air conditioners, tube TV, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, LCD TV, PDP TV, clothes dryers), tires, PC, motorbikes, farm tools and machinery, fishing nets, chemicals, fire extinguishers, containers of agricultural chemicals, explosives, batteries, medical instruments and large appliances (over 1m in length) and others that are not treated within the city will not be collected. Please consult with retailers or licensed dealers. (please refer to "waste & recycle guide" or homepage for licensed dealer information.)
- Waste from retail businesses such as stores, restaurants, factories, and offices is their own responsibility.

Waste Drop-off
[combustible waste], [noncombustible waste] (buried waste) only
free for less than 30kg once a day

Open/Monday to Friday 8:30am to 4:30pm <Closed on Saturday and Sunday>
*On holiday Wednesdays burnable waste can be dropped off at the Seiso Center.
*Please refer to the calendar for designated Sunday collection day. (10 times a year)

Futons, carpets and waste over 30kg one time produced from moving house have to be brought to the "Seiso Center". Tatami mats, closets or other large furniture (metallic objects removed) can be collected after confirming with "Seiso Center".
