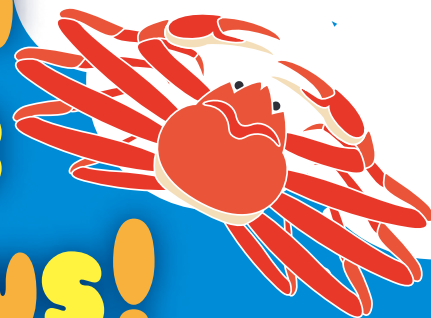

● Benten Rock and the Akebonobashi Bridge

Itsukushima Shrine is located in the middle of Benten-iwa. It is known as the guardian deity of the sea. Once you cross the red railed Akebonobashi Bridge, you can enjoy panoramic views of the Sea of Japan during the summer.

● Nou Beach (Swimming Area)

With sandy areas and rocky shores, this shallow beach is perfect for families with young children.

You can take your pick of benizuwai crab, purchase it and then eat it straight away at Kaniya Yokocho, where several shops selling benizuwai crabs are operated directly by the fishermen! You'll find Itoigawa's seasonal picks at the Fresh Fish Center, where you can enjoy summer exclusive specialty rock oysters and grilled seafood. Please enjoy the blessings of the geo-environment, which can only be experienced in Itoigawa, a designated UNESCO Global Geopark.
